

Peppa Pig's Patio Puddles Game

A fun game to play on your patio or in the playground

All you need are some coloured chinks, the printable paper dice (see page 2 for instructions) and an area of patio or concrete that's big enough to draw out the game board - about a 2.5 x 2.5 metre square should be big enough, but you can make it any size you like.

Get your little ones to help you draw out the game board on the patio using the chinks (see the sketch of the game board below). If you haven't got a ruler or straight edge, a good tip for getting the squares the same size is to use a plastic tray as a guide.

Draw the 'puddles' in another colour and shade them in if you like - brown or blue work best!


Print out and make the special Peppa Pig dice (instructions on page 2). **This will need to be done by a grown-up.**


The game plays a bit like snakes and ladders but players only move forwards. Each player begins on the start square - beginning with the youngest first.

Players take it in turns to roll the dice and move up the board the number of spaces rolled.

If they land on a puddle square, they get to jump up the board across the adjoining puddle squares (eg. from 11 up to 23).

The first one to reach the finish is the winner.





- 1 Print this dice template out onto an A4 sheet of paper or thin card.**
- 2 Cut around the outline with safety scissors.**
- 3 Fold along all of the dotted lines.**
- 4 Apply a small dab of glue or double sided tape to each of the tabs.**
- 5 Assemble the dice.**
